In the face of the COVID-19 pandemic, End Hunger Durham is partnering with local caterers to provide high-quality, nutritious meals for seniors living at low-income housing sites. Since March 21, we have served:

17,487 Meals

1,059 Seniors

17 Sites

Each delivery includes:

- Food for three meals with portions of protein, vegetables and starch.
- informational flyers about community resources, COVID guidelines, and more
- PPE such as disposable masks, cloth face coverings, and gloves for resident volunteers.

Funds raised for these meals also puts money back into the community by supporting the catering businesses, three of which are minority-owned: Bowick's Ark, Piri, Southern Harvest, and Zwelis.

"People here are head over heels with the meals. Some people don't have nobody. We try to help, but it's too much. We thought everybody had forgot about the seniors over here." - John Charity, President, Residents Assoc. at Carver Creek Apts.

Zwelis Catering adds informational flyers to the bags of food before they head out for delivery. Each resident receives two of these containers of food, enough for 3 meals.
